ISOLA DEL LIRI

Isola del Liri è attraversata e circondata dal fiume Liri. La città si chiamò nel passato "Insula Filiorum Petri" cioè isola dei Signori del luogo, i figli del castaldo longobardo Pietro il Maggiore. Divenne poi Isola di Sora e, dal 22 maggio 1869, Isola del Liri.

Dall'800 è stata a lungo un importante polo dell'industria cartaria, un'attività che ha lasciato molte tracce anche nel suo tessuto urbanistico. Oggi Isola è impegnata in un'operazione di recupero del suo passato. Di recente è stata riportata alla luce l'antica cartiera Béranger-Coste, poi Lefebvre, che diverrà sede del "Museo della Civiltà della Carta e delle Telecomunicazioni", in cui si potrà rivivere la centenaria tradizione cartaria di Isola

del Liri. Attrattiva, che mobilita visitatori da ogni dove, è la suggestiva Cascata "Grande": in pieno centro abitato compie un salto di circa 30 m., costituendo così un caso unico in Italia. Sulla sommità del luogo si staglia il medioevale Castello Boncompagni-Viscogliosi, monumento nazionale (sec. XIV-XVIII). Più volte rimaneggiato, conserva all'interno, nella Sala degli Stucchi, 18 altorilievi raffiguranti i domini della famiglia Boncompagni così come erano agli inizi del XVII secolo.

Tra le Chiese segnaliamo quella di San Lorenzo Martire, sec. XVII, che custodisce un pala d'altare (sec. XVI), affreschi e statue lignee di epoche diverse e un grande organo; la Chiesa di Santa Maria delle Forme in stile gotico, in fase di ristrutturazione; di Sant'Antonio che conserva un SS. Crocifisso tanto caro agli isolani; di Santa Maria dei Fiori con le campane in bronzo (1930-40) della fonderia locale "Antonio Loffredo".

Interessanti i resti di una torre di avvistamento sul colle di San Sebastiano, e dell'altra c.d. "di Cicerone" in loc. Carnello, nel cui circondario, dove il Fibreno si immette nel Liri, era la villa paterna del grande oratore.

Abitanti: 11.890 ca.; Altitudine: 268 m. s.l.m.; Piatti tipici: Spaghetti ai gamberi di fiume o di sugo di trota.

Isola del Liri is crossed and surrounded by the Liri River. In the past, the city was called " Insula Filiorum Petri ", that is, the island of the Lords of the place, the sons of the Longobard Steward Pietro il Maggiore. It later became Isola di Sora and, from 22 May

1869, Isola del Liri. Since the 19th century, it has long been an important centre for the paper industry, an activity that has also left many traces in its urban fabric. Today, Isola is engaged in an operation to recover its past. The ancient Béranger-Coste paper mill, later Lefebvre, was recently brought to light and will become the seat of the " Museum of Paper and Telecommunications Civilization ", where you can relivethecenturies-oldpaper-

making tradition of Isola del Liri. An attraction that attracts visitors from all over is the suggestive "Grande" waterfall: right in the centre of the town; it drops about 30 metres, making it unique in Italy. At the top of the place stands the medieval Boncompagni-Viscogliosi Castle, a national monument (14th-18th century). Remodeled several times, it preserves inside, in the Sala degli Stucchi, 18 high reliefs depicting the domains of the Boncompagni family as they were at the beginning of the 17th Century. Among the churches we point out that of San Lorenzo Martire, 17th century, which houses an altarpiece (16th century), frescos and wooden statues from different periods and a large organ; the church of Santa Maria delle Forme, in Gothic style, currently being renovated; Sant'Antonio which houses a SS. Crocifisso, very dear to the islanders; Santa Maria dei Fiori, with bronze bells (1930-40), from the local foundry "Antonio Loffredo". Interesting are the remains of a watchtower on the hill of San Sebastiano, and of the other so-called "Cicero's" in the locality of Carnello, in which district, where the Fibreno flows into the Liri, was the paternal villa of the great orator. Among the churches we point out that of San Lorenzo Martire, 17th century, which houses an altarpiece (16th century), frescos and wooden statues from different periods and a large organ; the church of Santa Maria delle Forme in Gothic style, currently being renovated; Sant'Antonio which houses a SS. Crocifisso so dear to the islanders; Santa Maria dei Fiori with bronze bells (1930-40), from the local foundry "Antonio Loffredo".

Population: 11890; Altitude: 268 m. asl; Traditional dishes: spaghetti with river shrimp, or with trout sauce. Settefrati, one of the most evocative religious events in Ciociaria.

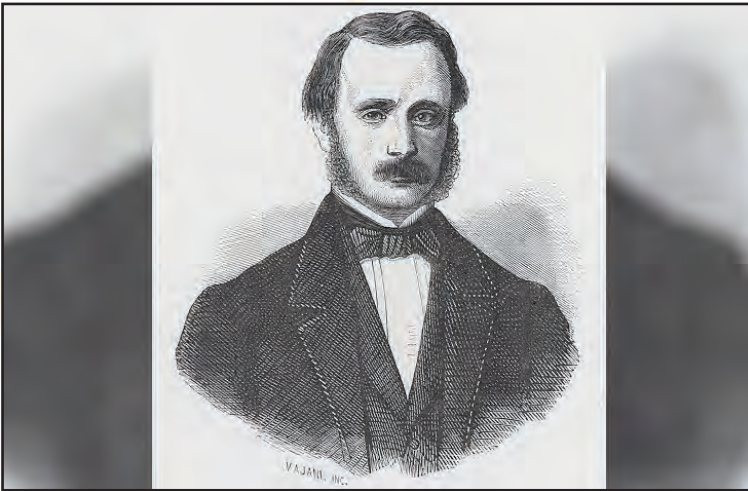

Giustiniano Nicolucci

Antropologo Nato a: Isola del Liri il 12 marzo 1819 – Morto a: Isola del Liri nel 1904. Giustiniano Nicolucci frequentò il Collegio Tulliano di Arpino, ove fu introdotto allo studio delle discipline classiche e scientifiche. Nel 1845, poco dopo aver conseguito la laurea in Medicina, durante i lavori del VII Congresso degli Scienziati italiani tenutosi a Napoli, ebbe modo di far conoscere i risultati di una propria ricerca medica condotta al microscopio. Privatamente, cominciò a maturare interessi nel campo "antropologico", fissandosi l'obiettivo di ordinare razze e stirpi del genere umano in complessi alberi genealogici. Nel 1852 a seguito di un viaggio compiuto in Europa che lo mise in contatto con studiosi stranieri, avviò attivi scambi di informazioni, conoscenze e materiali nell'ambito della "nuova scienza" antropologica. In tal modo costituiva il primo nucleo di un'importante collezione craniologica, e nel 1858 pubblicava la famosa opera "Delle Razze Umane", con la quale si affermava fra i pionieri dell'antropologia italiana ed europea. Nel 1880 Nicolucci ottenne la cattedra di Antropologia istituita per lui a Napoli, presso la Facoltà di Medicina e Chirurgia. Nei due decenni successivi egli diede alle stampe una produzione considerevole, in cui spiccano alcuni saggi sul darwinismo e, nel 1866, l'esauriente memoria, "Antropologia dell'Italia nell'Evo antico e moderno", dove venivano presi in esame tutti i popoli la cui presenza fosse stata accertata in Italia, tracciandone un profilo fisico e culturale. Notevole fu l'impegno profuso nell'arricchimento e nell'organizzazione del Museo fondato a Napoli annesso all'Istituto di Antropologia. Morì improvvisamente nella città natale nel 1904.

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Anthropologist, Born in Isola del Liri, on March 12, 1819 – Died in Isola del Liri in 1904, Giustiniano Nicolucci attended the Collegio Tulliano in Arpino, where he was introduced to the study of classical and scientific disciplines. In 1845, shortly after graduating in Medicine, during the proceedings of the VII Congress of Italian Scientists held in Naples, he had the opportunity to make known the results of his own medical research conducted under the microscope. Privately, he began to develop interests in the "anthropological" field, setting himself the goal of ordering the races and lineages of the human race in complex genealogical trees. In 1852, following a trip to Europe that put him in contact with foreign scholars, he began active exchanges of information, knowledge and materials in the field of the "new science" of anthropology. In this way he constituted the first nucleus of an important craniological collection, and in 1858 he published the famous work "Delle Razze Umane", with which he established himself as one of the pioneers of Italian and European anthropology. In 1880 Nicolucci obtained the chair of Anthropology established for him in Naples, at the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery. In the two decades that followed he published a considerable production, in which some essays on Darwinism stand out and, in 1866, the exhaustive memoir, "Anthropology of Italy in Ancient and Modern Times", where all the peoples whose presence had been ascertained in Italy were examined, tracing a physical and cultural profile. Considerable was the effort he put into enriching and organizing the Museum founded in Naples annexed to the Institute of Anthropology. He died suddenly in his hometown in 1904.
